ТЕКСТЫ

- A.** Hockey, tennis, figure skating, skiing, football, and other sports have always been popular in Russia. There are plenty of stadiums, sport clubs and gyms now. Many national and international matches and championships take place in Russia. The most important sports events are broadcast live from the stadiums. A lot of devoted fans come to watch the games; others prefer watching events on TV or online.
- B.** Children in Britain want to be independent from their parents. They can't work unless they're 13, but they wish to have their own pocket money. Some teenagers start working to earn money to pay for education. They babysit for some families in their neighbourhood. Some make money by designing clothes for friends and neighbours. Some children sell their old comic books or videos. They spend money on various things: mostly on fashionable clothes, music subscriptions or gadgets.
- C.** Teenagers from all around the world are becoming more and more concerned of today's global problems. Some of them take part in various environmental activities and join organisations, like "Greenpeace", for example. Some teens help old people and people with challenges. Many young people help ill and homeless animals and birds. Picking litter in parks and in the streets has become a popular activity with 'green' teens too. They try hard to make their country a better place.

- D.** Some time ago, large multinational companies in the U.S. got the right to patent seeds and plants. This makes farmers more dependent on them. For example, if they buy soybeans by a certain brand, they will have to sign a contract. The contract makes them use only this brand's chemicals, prohibits to replant seeds from the previous purchase and allows representatives of the company to visit their farms for up to 3 years after the purchase to make sure the farmers follow the contract.
- E.** Sir Laurence Olivier is world famous for his brilliant acting in theatre plays and films. He directed some of the most difficult stage and film productions at the time. He never thought about anything else except his image. This distinguished him from other popular actors. He was sure that nothing would make an actor great but his own personal qualities: artistic imagination, physical and spiritual strength. He died in 1989, but he is still remembered for his excellent job in cinematography.
- F.** Cheese rolling is a popular event that takes place on the Spring Bank Holiday on Monday. Participants roll a round cheese down a hill and chase it. The winner is the first person to grab the cheese. The show is spectacular to watch, but rather dangerous to take part in. The matter is that some competitors often end up with broken arms and legs. Coopers Hill is the most famous cheese rolling site in England.
- G.** Anacondas are lone creatures. They spend most of the time in rivers hunting for their food. Early European explorers of the South American jungles reported that they had seen anacondas up to 33 metres feet long, however, no anacondas of this size have ever been caught. Anacondas are known for their poor character. This fact and the size mean that anacondas are less popular as pets than other animals.
