Mikhail Lomonosov

Mikhail Lomonosov was born in 1711 in the northern coastal village of Denisovka not far from Archangelsk. He was a Russian scientist and writer who made an important contribution to literature, education and science. His father was a fisherman. When Mikhail was ten years of age his father began to take him sea fishing. After some years he gained admission to the Slavonic-Greek-Latin Academy. Mikhail studied very hard and made rapid progress. After a while he entered the Academy of Sciences. His ability and diligence attracted the attention of professors and as one of three best students he was sent abroad.

Lomonosov spent all the time there studying the works of leading European scientists in mathematics, chemistry, metallurgy and mining. On his return to Russia Mikhail Lomonosov was made a professor and then became a member of the Academy of Sciences.
